



Emergency Shelter at Interfaith Hospitality Network of Greater Cincinnati is not a building filled with beds. It is a community filled with neighbors that plan, cook, collect supplies, and offer what they have to families in need in their houses of worship. Motivated by personal faith, these neighbors don't just reach out to those experiencing homelessness, but to each other, to say we are one community and we can make it a better one by showing hospitality to parents and children with no place else to turn. In 2018, this gracious **hospitality** involved **25 host congregations** joined by **100 support congregations** and **42 funding congregations** that:





Shelter and hospitality are just the start! *Stable housing* is obtained and supported through holistic services provided by IHNGC's professional team. Those services include Aftercare, Child Enrichment, Pet Support, Permanent Supportive Housing, Rapid Re-Housing, and Shelter Diversion.



294 families including 709 kids were served across programs



94% obtained or maintained housing



89% did not return to homelessness



104 pets were helped to stay with their humans during homelessness
